Same-day visa (premium service)

As expert immigration solicitors in London, we are registered with the Home Office Public Enquiry Office ('PEO') in Croydon for a same day premium visa service. Our immigration team can submit your application to the PEO by hand and get a decision on the same day. Applicants will not need to attend the PEO unless the application requires their biometrics to be taken.

We are able to make applications using the same day service under the following categories:

- Tier 1 (General) of the points-based system
- Tier 1 (Post-study work) of the points-based system
- Tier 2 (General) of the points-based system
- Tier 4 of the points-based system
- Tier 5 of the points-based system
- Settlement (indefinite leave to remain) using application form SET(O)
- Settlement (indefinite leave to remain) using application form SET(M)
- Extension of stay (further leave to remain) using application form FLR(O)
- Extension of stay (further leave to remain) using application form FLR(M)
- Transfer of a residence permit using application form NTL

Appointments are requested every Monday for the following week and are allocated by the Home Office on a "first come, first served" basis.

There is a high level of demand for appointments to submit applications under the points-based system. Therefore as soon as we are instructed we will book an appointment in the client's name and a member of the immigration team will submit the application using the premium track for third-party representatives.

Applicants should be aware that the PEO will only decide applications on the same day if the application is straightforward and not complex. The PEO decides the majority of the applications we submit on the same day and very few applications are retained for further enquiries.

Once granted, the Biometric Residence Permit is usually sent to us by the Home Office within one week.
